#### **Nursery Places**

If your child (or you know of a child) who is currently 3 years old or has their 3<sup>rd</sup> birthday before the end of August, then please point them in the direction of our amazing Nursery as we currently have places available for a September start.

We are also able to offer places to children as soon as they turn 3 years old if they are in receipt of 2–3 year old funding. In this case, the nursery place can start immediately and the child does not have to wait until the term after their birthday. We have an excellent qualified teacher, Miss Worcester planning some amazing experiences for our nursery children, giving the children the very best start in life . We also find that children who have been to our Nursery are more likely to be 'school ready' than those who do not. If you are thinking of taking up a nursery place please contact school for a tour.

We continue to offer 30-hours free childcare if you meet the criteria set by the government. If you are not eligible for 30 hours, your child can still join our nursery on a paid, full time basis. Cost are £15 for an afternoon session with lunch provided or £13.50 if you would prefer to provide your child with a packed lunch. You are also able to 'pay as you go' and choose the days of the week that you would like your child to attend. Please speak to the office or call 01254 202600 for more information.



# **Behaviour Hub**

After significantly improving the quality of teaching by joining both the English Hub and Maths Hub over recent years, earlier this year we applied to join the Behaviour Hub alongside the Junior School. We have both been successful and joined the Hub earlier this term.

Behaviour in school is consistently good (as OFSTED confirmed earlier this acadmeic year), however I strongly believe it can be improved further. By working alongside the experts within the Behaviour Hub it will allow us to access high quality training and support to improve standards further to ensure we are doing everything we can at school to improve the life chances of all our children.


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#### **Attendance**

As a school we aim for all children to achieve 96% attendance. Every lesson really does count for your child as children can quickly fall behind even if one day is missed. Catching up even a little lost time from school can be really difficult for young children. Good attendance is linked to achievement, better relationships with other children and better overall behaviour in school. It is often the case that children with poor attendance are often academically behind their peers.

Poor attendance seriously hampers the life chances of your children.



Our attendance for this half term is 94.6% which is above the national average of 93.9% for the academic year. Well done everyone!!!
