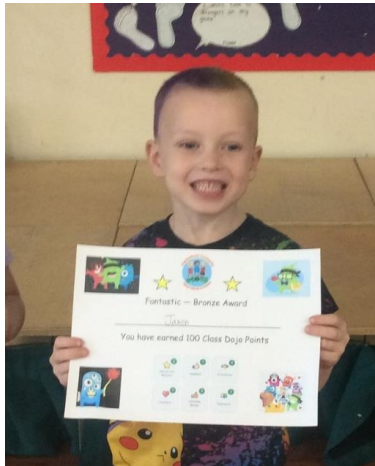

Reading

Those Who Read Succeed!

Please talk to your child about the book they are currently reading and foster a love of reading culture at home.

Why read 20 minutes at home?

Child A Reads:
20 minutes per day
3,600 minutes per school year
1,800,000 words per year

Child B Reads:
5 minutes per day
900 minutes per school year
282,000 words per year

Child C Reads:
1 minute per day
180 minutes per school year
8,000 words per year

The average word count for a typical novel is anywhere from 70,000 to 120,000 words

Between 15 and 25 books a year!



3 or 4 books a year



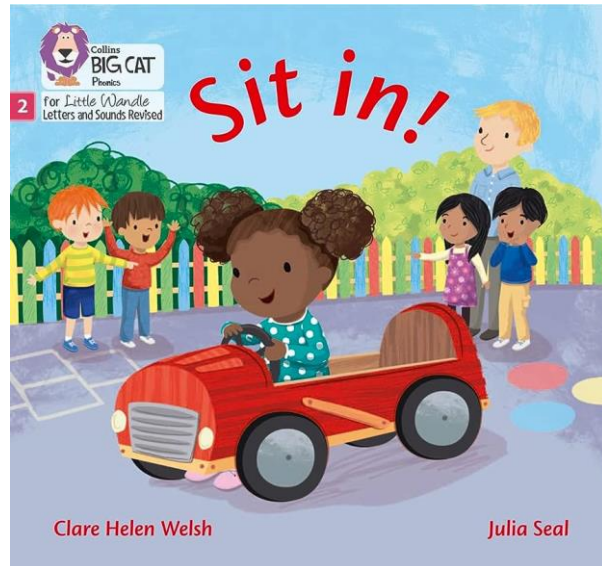
Less than one book per year

Reading Book



- Book for your child to read to you
- Goes home on a Tuesday
- Collected in on a Friday
- Ensure it is in your child's book bag every day



Sharing Book



- Book for you to read to your child
- Goes home nightly
- Children change it as and when

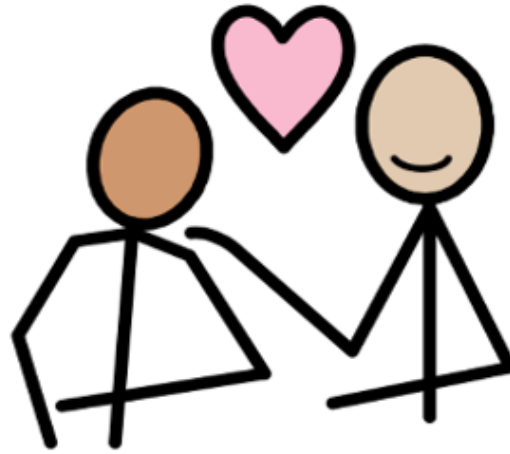

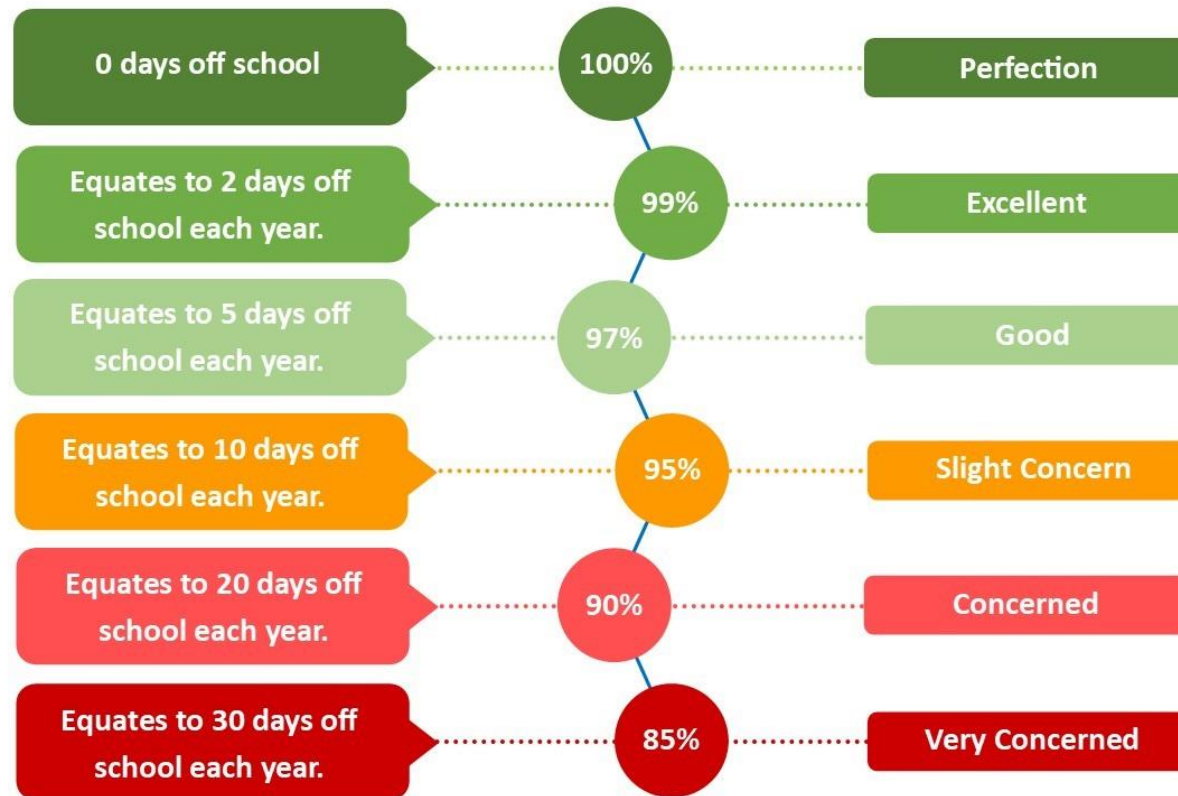
